

Homeschool Group Guidelines

We want everyone to feel welcomed, so we are setting up a few basic guidelines to protect the entire group.

The dress code is modest. Modesty is important for both men and women. No shorts or tight pants. No sleeveless, spaghetti strap, tank top, or mid-drift blouses. Shirts are required for men at all times. No sleeveless, tank top, mid-drift, or mesh shirts.

No smoking or vaping, no alcoholic beverages of any kind including wine or beer, and no drugs will be permitted when on outings or gathered as a group.

We ask you to be aware of the type of activity/toy and not to bring in anything to the group gatherings with dark/demonic origins such as batman, superman, Pokémon, power rangers, lord of the rings, harry potter, etc.

Proverbs 16:23-24 tell us that "Kind words are like honey - sweet to the soul and healthy for the body." Our goal should be to encourage and edify each other. So gossiping is a definite no-no. If you are upset with someone in the group, please go to them first and have a conversation seeking to resolve it. Many times, there is a misunderstanding or assumption at the root of frustration with one another. If there is still an unresolved problem, bring it to the leadership and do not allow it to sow seeds of discord in the group. (Matthew 18:15-17, Proverbs 6)

This group is based on Biblical principles and being Bible believers. As such, we will uphold the Bible as the absolute truth in the basis for all we do. The teaching of non-Biblical principles is not allowed nor are field trips to places encouraging non-Biblical teachings. Field Trips should be scheduled for Monday through Friday with no field trips on the Biblical Sabbath (Friday Sunset to Saturday sunset).
